Welcome to Bags, Baskets, & Bowls

You will need for this class, previous experience with sewing, preferably having taken lessons before. We will be drafting our own patterns for baskets and bags, so fabric amounts will vary.

## Also needed:

Full size sewing machine.

Sewing kit with all the basic notions.

For the first night bring a couple of Fat Quarters, nothing special, just some that we can plan and cut with, or random fabric that is at least the same size as a couple of Fat Quarters.

BONUS: If time allows we may work on mitered corners (napkins and tea towels). Thread of any color

I will have supply lists and handouts the first night of class, but as I stated above most of this will be some basic math and trial and error.

For the rope bowls you will need some fun colored multi-purposed thread (multicolor is great) if you have it, but if not it's fine.

50'80 feet of 7/32 or 1/4 inch thick clothesline.

Heavy Duty sewing machine Needles (16 or Denim)
