Allied Health Program Phlebotomy Technician Program w/Clinical Externship

This 90-hour program trains students to properly collect blood specimens for laboratory testing. Throughout the course, they will learn every aspect of the blood collection process and build the skills needed to perform venipunctures safely and accurately. Instruction includes classroom and lab work covering medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, blood collection methods, hands-on specimen practice, and the techniques required to perform various puncture procedures.
