Phlebotomy Technician Program with Clinical Externship

This 90-hour program prepares professionals to collect blood specimens from clients for the purpose of laboratory analysis. Students will become familiar with all aspects related to blood collection and develop comprehensive skills to perform venipunctures safely. Coursework includes terminology, anatomy and physiology, blood collection procedures, specimen handling, hands-on practice, and training in puncture techniques.

- Length: 12 weeks / 90 classroom contact hours + 80-hour clinical externship

- Not eligible for FAFSA (non-credit program)
